

DTEK's business activities

DTEK

DTEK is the leader on the Ukrainian markets for coal production and electricity generation, as well as a key player in the country's electricity distribution sector. It is also rapidly developing new business lines: wind power and trading operations.

Coal mining

DTEK's coal-mining division consists of the largest enterprises in the industry: DTEK Pavlogradugol (10 mines), DTEK Dobropolyeugol (5 mines) DTEK Rovenkianthracite (6 mines), DTEK Sverdlovanthracite (5 mines) and DTEK Mine Komsomolets Donbassa. DTEK's annual coal mining capacity is 37.5 million tones.

Coal preparation

DTEK has 11 coal preparation plants.

Equipment production and maintenance

Pershotravensky Repair and Engineering Plant repairs mining equipment, produces arch supports and hardware, rolls pipes, and makes steel and iron casts.

Electricity generation

DTEK's electricity generation capacity consists of Vostokenergo, Kievenergo (71.82%) and Zapadenergo (70.91%) and affiliates Dneproenergo (of which DTEK owns 47.55%). DTEK's renewable energy business is coordinated by subsidiary, Wind Power.

Electricity distribution

DTEK's electricity transmission and supply assets comprise Donetskoblenergo (of which DTEK owns 71.34%), Kievenergo (71.82%), Service-Invest and DTEK Energougol ENE.

Development of the oil and gas business

Vanco Prykerchenska Ltd was created to explore for and develop deep-water oil and gas deposits in the Prykerchenska Block of Ukraine's Black Sea.

Trading operations

DTEK's output is exported to markets in the CIS and Europe by DTEK Trading (coal) and Power Trade (electricity).
